(No Child Left Behind Act of 2001)

Targeted Assistance Programs Description

The purpose of a Title I targeted assistance (TA) program is to identify students experiencing academic difficulties and provide timely instructional assistance to help these students meet the State's challenging content and achievement standards.

Title I describes eligible children as those "identified by the school as failing, or most at risk of failing, to meet the State's challenging student achievement standards on the basis of multiple, educationally related, objective criteria established by the LEA."
