**REQUIREMENT**

LEAs are responsible for contacting officials in all private schools within the LEA attendance area to notify them of the opportunity for their students and teachers to obtain equitable services under the CARES Act.

**WHAT DOCUMENTATION DO I NEED TO COMPLETE?**

LEAs are required to be able to demonstrate it has made a good-faith effort to contact all the private schools in the LEA attendance area. An LEA will need to produce documentation to show that a good-faith effort was demonstrated. This document will meet the requirement.

**WHAT IS A "GOOD-FAITH EFFORT"?**

A "Good-Faith Effort" in the State of Alabama is at least 3 attempts to reach a private school using 2 or more methods (i.e. phone call, certified mail, returned receipt email, etc.).

**WHAT HAPPENS IF A PRIVATE SCHOOL DOES NOT RESPOND?**

If a private school declines to participate in the CARES Act programs or does not respond to an LEA's good-faith effort to make contact, the LEA has no further responsibility to provide equitable services to students or teachers at that school.
