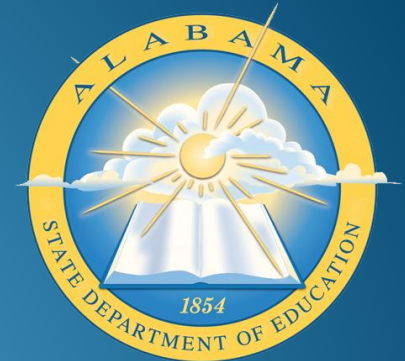

Approximately 35 years old



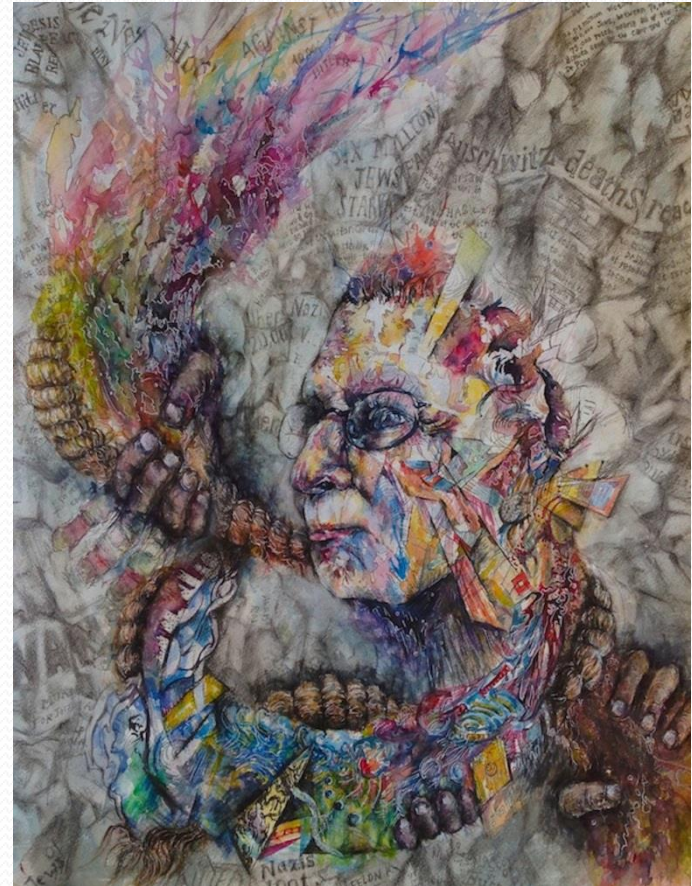
ANNUAL

- \$20-\$30,000 in grants

- Began in 2004-2005
- Started in Montgomery



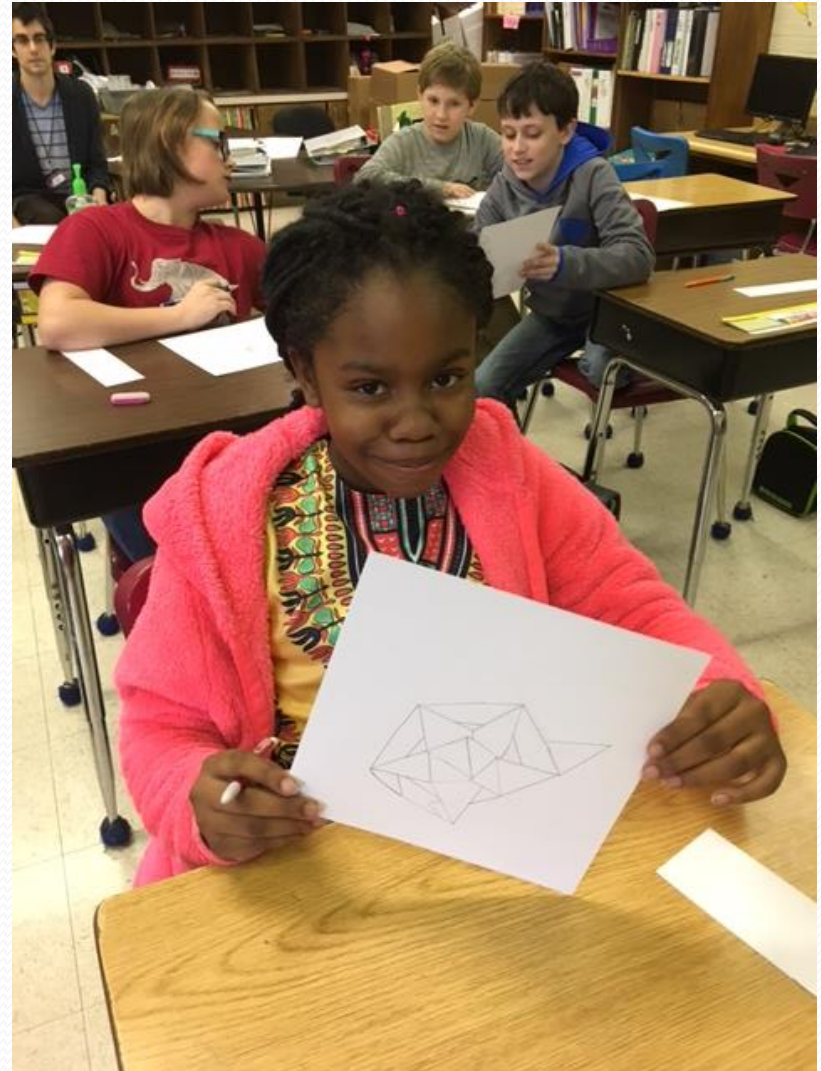
- Opened to Regions in 2007
- 98 Teachers
- 5772 students

- Began in 2007 – Governor's Black Belt Initiative
- \$150,000 for 15 school systems (\$10,000 each)
- Reduced to \$30,000 by 2013 due to legislative budget cuts (5-7 competitive grants)
- Using the ALC Goals to be competitive





- Began in 2013
- \$42,000-\$50,000
- 10 schools
- 8-10 artists
- 1,500 students
- Embedded Professional Development
- 2018-Adapt structure
